Losing Control

While Australian families struggle with rising cost of living pressures, Labor's Budget has cut support for families, raised taxes, racked up a record debt and ignored the Carbon Tax.

X More cost of living pressures on families

Labor is stripping \$2 billion from families by freezing key family tax payments and thresholds at a time when families are struggling with rising living costs. **All families** receiving Family Tax benefits will have some benefits stripped. On top of that, Labor is hitting Australians with \$6 billion in new and higher taxes – including a Flood Tax.

X A Carbon Tax to increase prices

Under the Gillard-Brown Carbon Tax, average **power bills are expected to rise \$300 a year**, petrol prices to increase by 6.5c a litre and grocery prices to rise by 5 per cent.

X More debt and deficit

Wasteful and reckless spending has blown out Australia's debt to a record \$107 billion. **Every day, Labor is borrowing \$135 million** just to pay for its reckless spending. This is putting unnecessary upward pressure on interest rates.

X Billions wasted and mismanaged

Australians are still paying for Labor's mismanagement and waste like the school halls mess and the home insulation scheme. And now **Labor's failure to control our borders has created a \$1.75 billion blowout** in the cost of managing our detention centres meaning families are missing out.
